

## Dear Friend, You saved my life!

When I was five years old, my parents could no longer afford to keep me. They put me on the street in Ghana to fend for myself. I found a dump where I could scavenge scraps to stay alive. I was always dirty with torn clothes which indicated to strangers that I had no parents to protect me.

Because I appeared neglected, I was the constant victim of sexual abuse. One day a man and woman sold me into child sex trafficking. It was horrific! I tried several times to run away and one day I succeeded.

A kind woman from another country was on a mission trip and visiting our village. She took me into a safe house along with three other girls. They gave each of us a handmade dress to wear, a doll and a pair of underwear. The dress was made by a group of women from Rochester, NY who are part of Dress a Girl Around the World.

That dress changed my life. I felt love - love from someone I would likely never meet. The dress gave me hope and protected me for the first time.

Now I am going to school and for the first time, learning to read and write. My dream is to continue my education and dedicate my life to helping others, as you have helped me.

All I knew was horror until the day I walked into the safe house for young girls. To this day, 14 years later, I can still barely speak about what happened to me.

I now know I am a precious gift from God. He calls me HIS masterpiece.

- Human Trafficking Awareness and Education provides tools and knowledge for groups to gain awareness of and prevent human trafficking
- Dress a Girl around the World provides dresses to girls around the world, so they won't be a likely target for human traffickers
- Butterfly Boutique provides free clothing to women entering the workforce from situations of abuse, recovery, re-entry from incarceration, or unemployment
